October is Breast Cancer Awareness month and the staff of JoAnn Bridges Academy held a month- long symposium, providing students with weekly opportunities to learn the basics of what breast cancer is, understand risk factors, learn prevention strategies and identify the warning signs for early detection.

With one in eight women expected to develop breast cancer in her lifetime, the young women of JBA have taken steps to protect themselves through knowledge and understanding.
