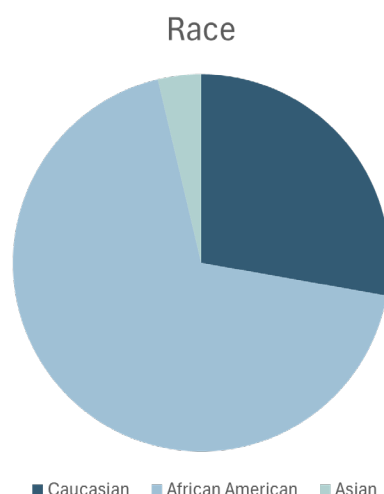
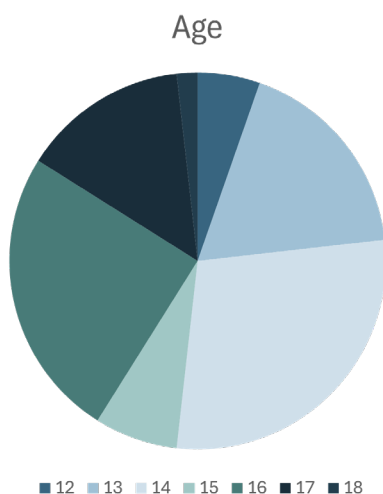
2024 ANNUAL REPORT



JoAnn Bridges Academy is a gender-specific residential treatment program that provides a safe, supportive and nurturing environment in which young women can learn and grow. Our program features evidence-based practices and mental health overlay services (MHOS) within a normalized, trauma-focused environment.

Operated in partnership with the Florida Department of Juvenile Justice, this program serves young women between 12 to 18.

DEMOGRAPHICS OF YOUTH SERVED



2024 OUTCOMES

- 15 years old was the average age in 2024
- 2 high school diplomas and 6 GEDs awarded
- 8.7 hours of treatment services provided per youth each week
- 87% of families participated in the Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) process
- 5.8 average family contacts per youth each month
- 10.6 hours of PYD activities provided to each youth each week
